



T3 PLEDGE COMMITMENTS & DEADLINES

PLEDGE

Deadline: December 1 or May 1

- **Step One:** Take the T3 Pledge by **DECEMBER 1** (Senior Deadline) or **MAY 1** (Junior Deadline) to confirm interest in receiving T3 program benefits like scholarships, persistence coaching, & more!
- **Step Two:** Visit your GO Center to meet with a college and career advisor (at participating high schools) to learn what it means to be a T3 Scholar & what steps you need to take to gain access to T3 benefits.

APPLY

Deadline: Varies by partner college/university

For guaranteed T3 scholarship consideration, apply to T3 partner institution(s) of interest by the deadlines below (including all supporting documents)¹:

February 1	Texas Christian University
February 15	The University of Texas at Arlington University of North Texas (Denton) Texas Woman's University (apply by Feb 1, for merit scholarship consideration)
February 16	Tarleton State University
April 1	Texas Wesleyan University
May 1	University of North Texas Dallas
July 1	Tarrant County College

¹ If applying after the guaranteed scholarship consideration deadlines, funds are based on availability only (all UTA & UNT-Denton deadlines are FINAL)



SUBMIT

Deadline: Varies by partner college/university

For guaranteed T3 scholarship consideration, submit a FAFSA or TASFA to the T3 partner institution(s) of interest by the deadlines below²: Please note given the changes to the FAFSA deadlines may shift.

February 1	Texas Christian University
February 15	Texas Woman's University
March 1	The University of Texas at Arlington (includes verification) University of North Texas Denton
March 15	Tarleton State University (priority deadline)
April 1	Texas Wesleyan University
May 1	Tarleton State University (final deadline) University of North Texas at Dallas
July 15	Tarrant County College

ENROLL

Deadline: Varies by partner college/university

- **Step One:** Create a profile on T3 Connect if I decide to attend a T3 partner college/university.

- **Step Two:** Use the Summer to Register for fall semester classes immediately following high school graduation & complete enrollment steps required by the T3 partner college/university.

² For UTA & UNT-Denton, financial aid deadlines include all supporting documents & verification (if selected) as listed. Therefore, it is recommended to submit your FAFSA/TASFA at least 4-6 weeks in advance of these dates to ensure you complete all necessary steps.
